5 times award winner Stefanie Rummel performs "Chansons" on demand and live on Zoom at the Living Record Festival 2022

Chansons – "French Songs & Stories from Piaf, Brel & Me" now can be seen on demand and live online at the Living Record Festival 2022 in the UK which takes place from the 17th of January until the 22nd of February. The show "Chansons" premiered in Germany in 2019. Despite the lockdowns, Stefanie Rummel has performed online in cabarets in New York and San Francisco, at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, CARTs, Lathi Fringe Festival and live at the Reykjavik Fringe Festival.

"Chansons" was nominated for "Producer of the Year 2021" by "The TheaterMakers Studio" from the Tony Award winner Ken Davenport.

The show stands for 'touching' stories about life and passionate songs from 'Ne me quitte pas' (Brel) to 'Milord' (Piaf). Sung and performed in the form of 'brilliant show interludes' by Stefanie Rummel (singing/acting) and accompanied by her pianists.

You become part of the French way of life without traveling and having jet lag. It doesn't matter if you speak French or not. Everything is explained in English. Audience members described Chansons as a 'heart connecting performance'. By looking at other cultures, you can reflect wonderfully on your own life and be inspired. How do we spend time? What is important to us in life?

The show won 1st place in the category "Chansons" at the German Rock and Pop Award 2022. In 4 other categories "Best Composition", "Best Music Video", "Best Female Musical Singer", "Best Female Pop Singer" awards were given.

In the category "Best Composition" Stefanie Rummel won 2nd place with the chanson "Art". She wrote this multimedia produced chanson in French and English for the Marsh Stream and Solo Art Heals in San



Francisco. The chanson is about the effect, art has on us. Art is a source of inspiration, of meditation, of feeling, of reflection, of creating strength. This is more important than ever.

The music video "Frére Jacques" won 2nd place. This "chanson" has been translated into 120 languages. Regardless of cultures, this song connects people all over the world. Stefanie Rummel sings "Frére Jacques" in 16 different languages. The different cultures and voices are characterized by different puppets who are united by music. The artist talks about the effect of music beyond the borders of countries and languages.

"Where have all the flowers gone" won third place in the category "Best female folk singer". In English, Icelandic, German, French, Stefanie Rummel interprets this haunting anti-war song by Pete Seeger. This song was sung by Marlene Dietrich and stories around it are told. Another chanson "My way" or "Comme d'habitude" won 3rd place in the category "Best Female Musical Singer".

"Chansons" is characterized by French chansons interpreted in different languages, subtle autobiographical stories, and individual exchange with the audience and intercultural outlooks. For more information, visit: www.stefanierummel.com and www.chansons.show

Stefanie Rummel

The multi-award winning singer, tap dancer, magician and musical theatre actress Stefanie Rummel has won awards or been a finalist in various singing competitions, nationally and on television. Recently, she received 5 awards for her work with Chansons. 1st Best Chansons, 2nd Best Music Video, 2nd Best Composer, 3rd Best Musical & Folk Song.

Having lived in France, Germany and the US, Stefanie Rummel shares her intercultural experiences in her show "Chansons". Songs from Paris to Hollywood – from "Piaf, Brel, Zaz & Me" are connected to very personal stories about the love of life.

"Chansons" has been invited to festivals such as the Reykjavik Fringe Festival, Lathi Fringe Festival, Edinburgh Fringe Festival, Living Records Festival....

Stefanie Rummels' Gala Acts, One-Woman-Shows and Musical Cabarets were performed in the US, UK, Norway, Iceland, France, Finland, Germany, Luxemburg... Her special quardruple acts "Song, Act, Tap & Magic" went on different tours, sang on cruise ships, at variety shows and galas. The shows are performed in English, German and French, depending on where she is.

As a voice specialist and Estill Mentor Course Instructor she gives master classes and talks on different singing styles internationally.

For 11 years she performed in the Musical "Nunsense" out which she played Sister Hubert for about 7 years in the longest running "Nunsense" show of the world. She was also seen in musicals such as "Kiss me Kate", "Sweet Charity", "Jesus Christ Superstar". 2021 she was nominated for "Producer of the Year" and "Theatermaker Choice" from the Tony Award winner Ken Davenports' Theatermaker Studio.


